



From the Rogue Region

What you need to know

Dress Accordingly

At an elevation of over 6000', it is often up to 10 degrees cooler at the rim than in the valleys and towns below.

It's Remote

Download your directions! You will be out of cellular range for much of the drive. GPS may be spotty or unreliable. While the drive is well signed, you'll want to print out or download your maps.

Have cash and/or a Senior Pass

Effective May 13, 2018 the entrance fees to the park will be \$25 per vehicle and \$20 per motorcycle. Then effective January 1, 2020 the entrance fees to the park will be \$30 per vehicle and \$25 per motorcycle. The America the Beautiful senior pass is accepted at Crater Lake National Park. A \$5 day use fee applies to popular trail heads, waterfalls and picnic spots.

Drive time: 3.5 Hours + Stops: 5 Hours = Total 8.5 Hours Round Trip

Crater Rock Museum: Stop in at the Crater Rock Museum in Central Point and let them know where you're headed. They'll give you some great information on what to look for, explanations of our local geology, plus they have thousands of beautiful polished gemstones and crystals to behold!
Recommended time: 30 minutes

The Fishin' Hole Fly Shop & Picnic Basket Delicatessen: Access to food is very limited in the wilderness around Crater Lake. Stop and pick up the perfect picnic lunch to enjoy at any of the scenic stops along the way.
Recommended time: 10 Minutes

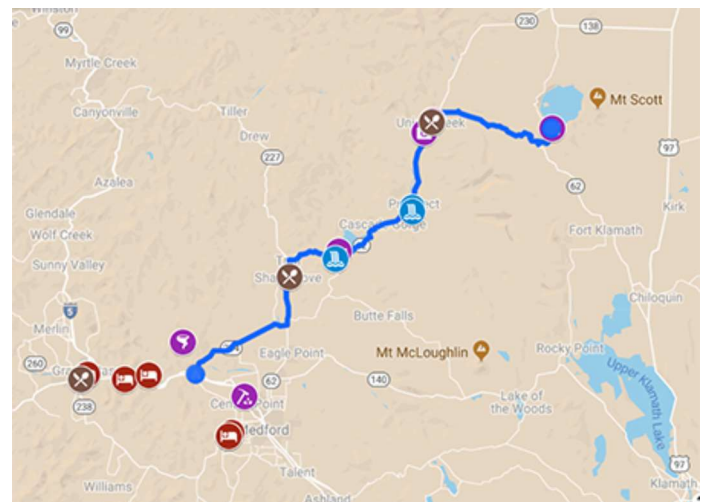
Cole Rivers Fish Hatchery: Feed the salmon and learn about sustainable fishing on the West Coast. Recommended time: 30 minutes

Mill & Barr Creek Waterfalls: Grab your camera, stretch your legs and enjoy these easy to moderate hikes to breathtaking waterfalls. Recommended time: 30 Minutes

Crater Lake: The premier destination. Check out the Rim Drive, hikes and other activities at the Rim Village Visitor center. Enjoy your picnic lunch,
Recommended time: 1 hour

Rogue River Gorge: An ADA accessible viewpoint and 0.3 mile trail to spectacular views of the Rogue River as it cascades through a deep basalt gorge. Recommended time: 15 minutes

Natural Bridge: Natural Bridge, a point located along the upper reaches of the Rogue River, is where the magic happens. At this point, the Rogue River disappears underground into a 250-foot lava tube, with a small amount of water escaping from the tube, forming a pool under the bridge. All of the water, slowly but surely, reappears at the surface further down the river.
Recommended time: 30 minutes



Becky's: Whew, time for some PIE and good food at famous Becky's in Union Creek. Recommended time: 30 minutes

Del Rio: You're almost back to populated areas. Stop in at Del Rio for late afternoon wine tasting, you-pick flowers, food and live music. Recommended time: 60 minutes.
